The Clerk stated that the scheduled meeting following the site visit on 7 October 2015 could not proceed due to the meeting being inquorate and therefore suggested that the Committee request that an additional member of the Property Committee be requested to serve on the Bandstand Management Committee following the Annual Council Meeting on 13 May 2015 to increase the membership from 3 members to 4 members. It was

RESOLVED: That a recommendation be made to full council that the membership of the Bandstand Management Committee be increased from 3 members to 4 members from the Property Committee and elected at the Annual Council Meeting on 13 May 2015. **162/015**

Repainting of the Bandstand

The Clerk had obtained three quotations for repainting the Bandstand as requested and these were circulated to members at the meeting. After due consideration a proposal was made by Cllr J Casey and seconded by Mr L Wing for Contractor No 2 to be recommended to the Finance & General Purposes Committee at a meeting to be held on 4 March 2015. It was noted that the funds for the repainting had been raised by sponsorship from local groups and organisations, local businesses and individuals. It was

RESOLVED: That a recommendation be made to the Finance & General Purposes Committee to give consideration to the Bandstand Management Committee's preferred option for repainting the Bandstand being Contractor No 2 with the expenditure being utilised from the Bandstand Reserve. **163/015**

Sponsors

Members were circulated with a report of all sponsors, donations and payable event bookings and the Clerk confirmed that a combined total to date from 1 April 2014 was £655.00. Members noted this was an excellent amount and were really encouraged by the support from local groups, organisations, businesses and individuals by sponsoring the Bandstand which was very much appreciated. Event Bookings - 2015

Members were circulated with a copy of event bookings for 2015 to date and noted that the Bandstand was being used by many local groups and organisations and that due to popularity the Town Council had increased its summer band concert programme from 10 weeks to 12 weeks. It was

Income and Expenditure Report

The Clerk circulated a financial report to Members which highlighted that income held in the Bandstand Reserve as at 31 March 2014 stood at £2047.60 which had been obtained mainly from sponsorship. Additional income of £655 had also been received this year from bookings and sponsorship and would cover the cost of repainting the Bandstand. It was

RESOLVED: That the Financial Report as at 24 February 2015 be accepted. 166/015

Any other matters relating to the Bandstand

The Clerk reported that the Bandstand lighting recently tripped out whenever a power cut occurs but Cllr J Casey had been shown by the electricians how to reset the lighting. The Clerk was requested to inform the Officer at Scarborough Borough Council who dealt with bookings for the bandstand in Peasholm Park that the Filey Bandstand was available to book. It was
