Crime Breakdown

14th June the windscreen of a moving vehicle was smashed with a shovel, the offender made off and was later arrested in Scarborough, he has been charged with a number of offences.

On 16th June at Tesco Store, Filey a male was detained for shop lifting, he was given a CRD and the goods returned to store.

There were 7 crimes of violence reported during the month of June, of these reports 6 were domestic related and one was an assault. A suspect has been identified for the assault and enquiries are ongoing.

Anti-Social Behaviour

During June there were 16 incidents of Anti-Social Behaviour reported, of these only 2 were youth related.

Traffic Breakdown

On 9th June on Mitford St a car collided with an invalid scooter whilst reversing. The driver of the scooter was taken to hospital where she received treatment for a cut to her leg and was later discharged.

Recording of Crimes connected to Harassment

In July 2017, the Crown Prosecution Service Inspectorate (CPSI) and Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabularies (HMIC) released a joint report relating to harassment and stalking. From this report, The Home Office amended how these crimes were recorded, this will see a rise in recorded crimes.

For example; currently if a victim reported to us that they had been stalked over a number of weeks by an ex-partner, culminating in an Assault and Criminal Damage to their vehicle, the current recording provision would mean that we would record:

1 x crime - Stalking, as this is the principal crime over the assault and damage.

Under the new provision we would need to record:

1 x crime – Stalking and;

1 x crime – Section 47 assault (the assault in the principal crime over the damage).
